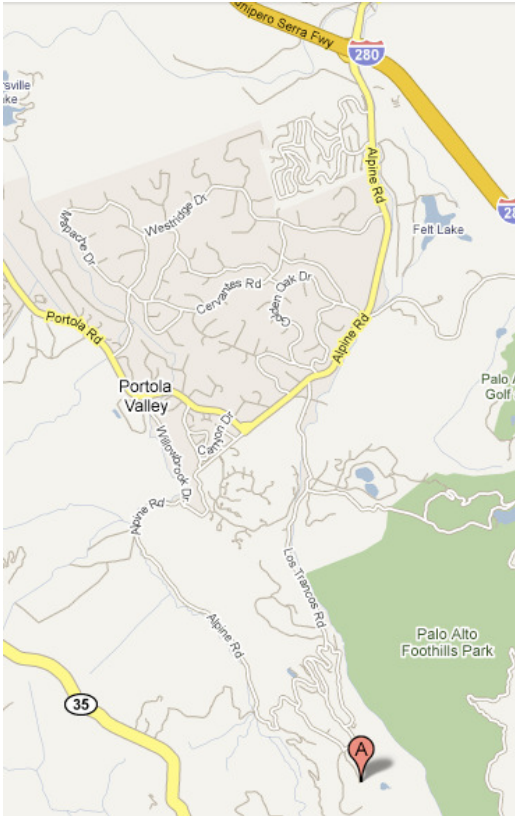


# MILITARY VEHICLE TECHNOLOGY FOUNDATION

## DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO MUSEUM



The museum is open to the public. Go to [www.MVTF.org](http://www.MVTF.org) to schedule a tour. Museum address:

**Please print these directions and use them when driving up to the museum. A lot of GPS / navigation systems do not work in the area.**

**From Interstate 280 Northbound or Southbound:**

Take the **Alpine Road Exit** (Portola Valley) and turn west, towards the hills, onto Alpine Road

Proceed on Alpine Road for approximately 2.4 miles.

Turn **LEFT** at **Los Trancos Road** and proceed for about 1.9 miles.

Turn **LEFT** on **Ramona Road** and proceed for about 0.7 miles.

Turn **LEFT** on **Vista Verde Way** and proceed for about 0.3 miles.

Turn **LEFT** at **Old Spanish Trail** and proceed on Old Spanish Trail for about 0.1 miles

Old Spanish Trail will end at an iron gate with a sign reading "Pony Tracks Ranch". Pull up close to the gates and they will open automatically. Drive straight through the gate onto the ranch road and take the first and hard **LEFT onto the gravel road**. **Follow the signs** down the **gravel road**, drive past the wooden structure labeled "Office", until you reach a complex of **FOUR LARGE METAL BUILDINGS**. Park in the paved courtyard on the left.
